



ENGLISH AS A SECOND LANGUAGE COUNCIL

TEACHER BURSARY

This bursary was created in 2010 as a way to support our members in their educational endeavours related to the field of English as a Second Language and to encourage them to write in ACCENT. This bursary covers \$300 towards a post-secondary course (excluding student fees) for the current academic school year. A maximum of four bursaries are available each year.

Criteria

- Must be a current ESL-C member
- Attending a post-secondary course related to English as a Second Language
- Submit bursary application form prior to course start date to ESL-C president
- Must write one or more articles for publication in ACCENT pertaining to the course taken and 500-750 words in length;
- Provide transcript of course completion

Process

- Applications are due April 30 for spring/ summer courses and September 30 for fall/winter courses
- Bursary applicants are reviewed and a maximum of four applicants will be randomly drawn by Table Officers at the June and November meetings
- Cheque is issued upon receipt of first ACCENT article AND transcript

Conditions

- Successful applicants will be ineligible to apply for 3 years from date of bursary approval
- ESL-C Table Officers are not eligible to apply
